Cultivate


Cultivate groundbreaking partnerships in the region.

HUMANITARIAN AID

- In just two years, MFA has delivered **more than \$137 million** in medicines, hospital equipment, food, clothing, and other supplies to those in desperate need inside Syria and in bordering refugee camps.
- Our established international network of relief suppliers and NGO partners inside Syria mean that we can get there relief needed — and ensure distribution to the right people — at the right time.
- By developing groundbreaking cross-border partnerships, MFA has delivered massive amounts of aid through Israel into Syria.
- MFA has now expanded its relief efforts into northern Syria, where more than 5 million people struggle for survival against the chaos of warfare and extremism.

- MFA counters anti-refugee sentiments by advocating for sensible and humane refugee policies that reflect American values and the contribution of refugees to the fabric and strength of our society.
- MFA's policy reform platform embraces U.S. policies that recognize that our national security and economic interests support increased Syrian refugee admissions and appropriate funding for refugee resettlement and foreign aid.

RAISING AWARENESS

- As the war continues into its eighth year, a key priority for MFA is keeping the public focused on the Syrian crisis. MFA combats the three great fears about Syrian refugees — economic displacement, terrorism and Islamophobia.
- MFA brings attention to the crisis through activities ranging from speaking engagements and community mobilization, to volunteer relief packing events. From appearances on *CNN* and in-depth interviews on *The New Yorker Radio Hour* to an above-the-fold article in *The New York Times*, MFA continues to keep focus on the crisis in the media.
- MFA's video series, *Syrian Voices*, shares the personal stories of Syrians. Dedicated to the resilience of the Syrian people, *Syrian Voices* aims to help us all better understand the impact of the humanitarian crisis by providing a forum for Syrians to speak in their own words.
